

Legal note – Terms and Conditions

Angloville is committed to providing the highest standards of education and conduct. The main function of this legal note is for us at Angloville to fulfil our responsibility to make you aware of some important aspects of local law. It would be remiss of us not to do this. At Angloville we work with many individuals from different backgrounds, thus, compliance with the law and high standards of behaviour is mandatory. The following rules apply to everyone: coordinators, native English speakers, and participants.

The management of Angloville, and the coordinators of your program care about everyone's safety. We want to make you feel as welcome as possible, you are giving up your time to help the participants improve their language skills. In return, we want to provide you with a memorable and stress-free experience. The legal language used may seem rather direct, but please don't be overly concerned as your coordinator will go through these points with you. By submitting your application to Angloville, you acknowledge that you have read and understood the content of this form. You will also be required to sign a printed copy of this form at the beginning of the Angloville program. Thank you.

1. I hereby declare that I have no criminal record.
2. For safety reasons I declare that I have informed the Angloville Organisers of any mental or physical conditions that I have.
3. I undertake to act responsibly and reasonably in compliance with the widely acceptable standards of good behavior.
4. I am aware that any act of violence, harassment, sexual harassment or other type of abuse will be immediately reported to the police which may lead to arrest and prosecution.
5. I am aware that excessive consumption of alcohol is strictly forbidden and may lead to being expelled from the program at my own cost at the discretion of the Angloville coordinators.
6. I am aware that any form of gross misconduct/criminal activity will lead to being expelled from the program at my own cost, at the discretion of the Angloville coordinators. Consequently I could be facing legal consequences in the host country. This information may be passed to my university / employer, and the local police in my country.
7. Any use of illicit and/or illegal drugs is strictly forbidden and will be reported to the police immediately. I have been informed that this may lead to prosecution and a prison sentence of up to 15 years.
8. I acknowledge that I will be financially responsible for any and all damages I may cause to the hotel facilities and equipment, and that my details will be passed on to the hotel managers if such damages occur.
9. I understand that during the program pictures/video footage may be taken by the program coordinators and that I may appear on those. I understand that those pictures/video may be used for the purposes of Angloville marketing and advertising and also for the purposes of being sent to participants upon their request. (please let the coordinators know at the beginning of the program, if you do not want to appear on pictures/video)
